## **Placer County Health and Safety Guidelines for Dance Students**

- Students remain in individual's care until signaled by Teacher and will enter through the main front door of the classroom.
- Students must wear facemask (non-medical) when leaving the car, entering the classroom, during class time, standing in line and during exit from class back to their car.
- Students will be patient as the Teacher or Assistant takes individual temperature.
- If the Student registers a temperature at or above 100.4 degrees, the parent will be notified and politely asked to have the student taken out of the classroom.
- If the Student is not feeling well, they should report to the teacher immediately and the parent will be notified and politely asked to have the student taken out of the classroom.
- Students are encouraged to use hand sanitizer before class begins and when or if a shoe change or clothing change is required.
- Students should have hair pulled back during class to avoid touching their face.
- Students must ask to use the restroom and must wash hands after use.
- Saturday Students will be allowed one parent/guardian to accompany during class time. Parents/guardians must remain seated and keep at least 6 feet apart.
- Saturday Parents/guardians must wear a facemask (non-medical) from the time they leave their car until the time they return to their car.
- Saturday Parents/guardians are encouraged to use hand sanitizer and wash hands after restroom use.
- Saturday Students and Parents/guardians must exit together after the class and through the side exit.
