Health & Safety Guidelines at The Dance Gallery 2



- We recommend Students wear face masks when inside the studio building.
- Students are encouraged to continue practicing social distancing, hand sanitizer before class begins and when or if a shoe change or clothing change is required.
- If the Student is not feeling well, they should report to the teacher immediately and the parent will be notified and politely asked to have the student taken out of the classroom.
- All Students may invite one parent/visitor to accompany during class time. Parents/visitors are requested to remain seated in the observation area and practice social distancing. We also recommend that Parents/visitors wear a face mask while seated in the observation area.
- All Parents/visitors are encouraged to use hand sanitizer and wash hands after restroom use.
- Students 3 yrs through 6 yrs are not asked to wear face masks, but certainly can wear one if they prefer to.
- Teachers and Student Teachers will continue to sanitize the classrooms by using the hospital grade foggers after each class.
