

WHAT TO WEAR TO CLASS

It's not only important to act like a dancer but also to dress like a dancer. Appropriate dance clothes are required for class. Loose fit clothes can make it difficult for teachers to give appropriate feedback. Please have a packed dance bag with extra options.

Hair MUST be out of face for class (required)
